Students will have the option to take extra units and pay for extra tuition fees, in order to fulfill their home universities' requirements.</p>
<p>Grading System</p>	<p>Final grades can be determined by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Essays, tutorials, presentations and group work as well as written final exams and/or projects ● In-class participation
<p>Orientation</p>	<p>On the first day of the program, students should attend the program orientation at SDSU. During the orientation, information about the university, class registration, the city of San Diego and more will be provided. There will be welcome events for international students in the program to meet each others.</p>

Application	<p>To apply for a study abroad semester at San Diego State University, please prepare the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Proof of English proficiency: DAAD (B2 level), TOEFL 61, IELTS 5.5 or Duolingo 90 ● Official transcript for the current program of study as well as an English Bachelor's certificate, including all courses taken for all Master's students ● Financial Statement showing proof of 18,000 USD (Master's and Bachelor's students). For this, SDSU requires official confirmation from a bank in English. ● Valid copy of passport
Application Deadline	<p>SDSU is operating on rolling admission. That means that there is no clear deadline for either fall or spring. However, we recommend students to turn in their application:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● for Fall - until the 1st of April ● for Spring - until the 1st of October <p>Please contact the World of Students team in the case of a late application.</p>
Visa This information is supplied without liability.	<p>To study abroad at SDSU, international students need an F-1 student visa. This visa allows students to be enrolled as a full-time student at an American university. Students may enter the US 30 days before the I-20 start date and may stay for up to 60 days after the program end date on their I-20. Students typically use the 60 day grace period after the end of their studies to travel within the USA. Students can request an F-1 visa only after their application is approved and after receiving their I-20 form. Visas can only be requested at US embassies and consulates.</p>
Accommodation *Fees are subject to change	<p>SDSU offers a limited number of on-campus apartments, however most international students prefer to search for their own (shared) apartment near campus or the beach. SDSU offers assistance in finding a suitable apartment or room, with appropriate search resources and contacts.
