What is Semester at SJSU (SAS)?

A unique opportunity for international students to enroll in one or two semesters of full-time undergraduate or graduate study at San José State University.

As an SAS student you can:

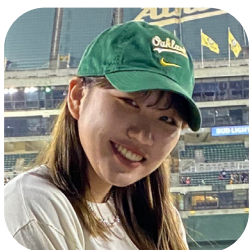
- Enroll in 12 units of undergraduate level SJSU as an F1 student.
- Enroll in 9 units of graduate study (200 level) for eligible applicants.
- Receive an official SJSU transcript with your earned course credits.
- Transfer earned course credits to other colleges or universities.
- Access to guest lectures from entrepreneurs and technology industry experts from Silicon Valley.

Application Deadlines

Spring Semester: November

Fall Semester: July

We advise you to apply 2 – 3 months before your program start date so you can arrange for your visa and housing.



Tuition, Fees and Living Expenses (one semester)

Application Fee: \$150 (non-refundable)

Tuition: \$7,350 includes 12 undergraduate course units or 9 graduate course units

Extra Unit Fees: \$400/unit for 13 or more undergraduate course units or 10 or more graduate course units

Estimated Living Expenses: \$12,500
