Full Board: 3 meals per day	Typically students will prepare their own breakfast & lunch and host prepares dinner. The full board program is required for all Minors under 19.
Half Board: breakfast and dinner	Breakfast is typical breakfast items in regular portions such as: cereal, toast, juice, coffee, bagel, eggs, fruit or yogurt. Half board does not include taking food or snacks from the home to consume at school or while out.
Room Stay: no meals	<b>LIMITED AVAILABILITY.</b> Access to kitchen and refrigerator storage shelves and cooking facilities are expected for foods students purchase and prepare for themselves. Students are responsible for cleaning the kitchen after use.

#### CHN's refund policy will apply to cancellations.

Note: The Excise Tax Act defines which services and homestay host allowances attract GST or HST. Canada Homestay Network Society is registered to collect and remit GST/HST on certain services, including, but not limited to, (a) Registration, Placement and Orientation fee provided to students registered after their arrival in Canada; (b) Airport transfers; (c) Daily host transportation allowances; and (d) Daily host allowances for students staying in homestay for less than one month.
