1. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

- Declaration of Financial Support Form
- Curriculum Vitae

After receiving USIL Acceptance Letter:

- Flight Tickets (arrival and departure dates)

2. REVISION PROCESS

Once the application has been submitted, one of our executives will proceed to review your application. In case there were any observations, a message will be sent to the student's email address.

You will need to send your flight tickets (arrival/departure) where the student's data can be viewed and the dates are within the period requested and insured.

If the documents are complete and correctly submitted with all the requirements, students will receive their **USIL Acceptance Letter.**

3. LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to have a **B2 level proficiency to take courses taught in English.** In case the student would like to take courses taught in Spanish, they will be asked to complete the Spanish Placement Test (SPT) through an evaluation in order to know their Spanish Level.

SPANISH PLACEMENT TEST

If the student is not native in Spanish, they will need to take the test.

The test applies for students who:

- · Want to take courses taught in Spanish.
- Want to take the Spanish Language course; but do not want to start from the Elemental Spanish class (already have any previous knowledge) and do not have a certificate or a transcript

NOTE:

In case you have a Spanish Certificate, you can send it to inboundmobility@usil.edu.pe and the Language Department will place you to corresponding level.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION (ESTIMATE)

MONEY EXCHANGE

Exchange a small amount at the airport just in case SOLES are needed. You should bring Euros or US Dollars. We recommend exchanging some at the airport. Also, VISA and Mastercard are widely accepted and used in most establishments. However, for buying souvenirs we would recommend having some cash.

Exchange at the bank or find a designated government official wearing the vests indicating they are official workers to exchange money. There are many authorized Money Exchange establishments in Miraflores and in La Molina.

LOCAL CURRENCY

There are bills with denominations of 10, 20, 50, 100, and 200 soles.



There are also coins of 10,20 and 50 cents as well as 1,2 and 5 soles.

- Taxi: US\$3 US\$10 approximately (depending on the distance)
