Students at Victoria University of Wellington are a **diverse** and **vibrant** community, reflecting both local and global perspectives. They are typically:

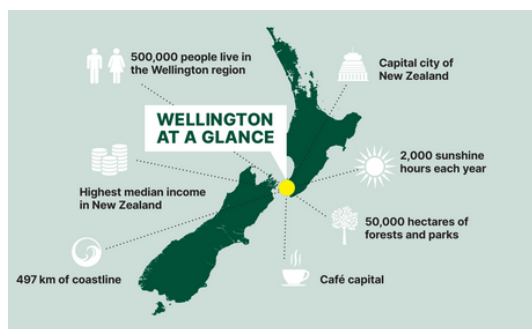
