To apply for a study abroad semester at San Diego State University, please prepare the following documents:

- Proof of English proficiency: DAAD (B2 level), TOEFL 64, IELTS 5.5 or Duolingo 95
- Official transcript for the current program of study as well as an English Bachelor's certificate, including all courses taken for all Master's students
- **Financial Statement** showing proof of 18,300 USD (Master's and Bachelor's students). For this, SDSU requires official confirmation from a bank in English.
- Valid copy of passport

Academic Calendar

Fall & Spring Semester

SDSU has a semester system:

- Fall semester: August December
- Spring semester: January May

SDSU is operating on rolling admission. That means that there is no clear deadline for either fall or spring. However, we recommend that students submit their application by April 1 for Fall intake and by October 1 for Spring intake. Please contact the World of Students team in the case of a late application.



Visa Information

F-1 student visa

To study abroad at SDSU, international students need an F-1 student visa. With this visa students may enter the US 30 days before the semester start date and may stay for up to 60 days after the program end date. Students can request an F-1 visa only after their application is approved and after receiving their I-20 form.


Study Abroad Term BA*1,2: 7,300 (24 ECTS) - 8,308 USD (30 ECTS)

Study Abroad Term MA*^{1,2}: 7,300 (18 ECTS) - 8,509 USD (24 ECTS)

Application Fee (one-time): 175 USD

Bachelor-level students are required to take a minimum of 12 undergraduate-units (24 ECTS), and master-level students are required to take a minimum of 9 graduate-units. Students will have the option to take extra units and pay for extra tuition fees, in order to fulfill their home universities' requirements.
