- Language certificate: for example TOEFL iBT 70, DAAD certificate (B2), Duolingo (95) etc.
- Transcript of Records in English
- Master students: **Bachelor's certificate** in English including all courses taken
- Copy of passport
- Financial Statement of 19,998 USD

Visa Information

F-1 student visa

At SFC you have two options regarding the visa:

• F-1 visa: normal student visa

• **J-1 visa:** visa for the semester at SFC + an internship afterwards

Grace Period: The grace period is the period in which you can travel in the US outside of the semester.

• **F-1 visa:** 90 days

• **J-1 visa:** 60 days
