LIVING EXPENSES

Living costs to study in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia are relatively affordable compared to other countries. This is a major advantage for international students when choosing to study in Malaysia. Estimated living cost (including accommodation and food etc) is RM 1,800 - RM 2,500 (approx. USD 450-USD 650) per month depending on the living lifestyle of the students.



INTAKES

Each semester at APU consists of 14 teaching weeks, a study break and an exam period. The total duration of a semester is estimated to be around 18 weeks.
